HOME HEATING OIL SAVING SCHEME – RUN BY NORTHERN IRELAND HOUSING EXECUTIVE – OPEN TO ALL.

This is a group buying scheme. After you register for free you will get a text message or email every week asking you to place a tentative order for oil (how many litres you may need either 500 or 200, there is no commitment to buy oil at this point). Two days later you will get a response giving you the price and best supplier with a discount code for you to use, which could save you £10-£15 on your order. To register email your Name, Postcode and Mobile Number to oilsavings@nihe.gov.uk Also be aware that this scheme means you can save more on small deliveries, so it might be better to order 200L every few weeks instead of ordering 600L at once.
