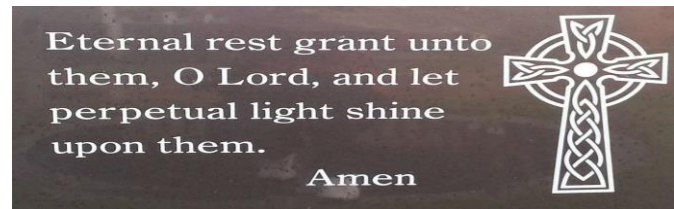

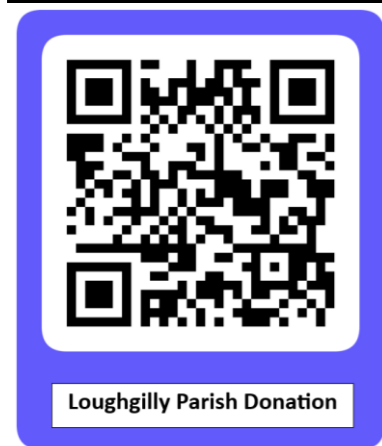

ST MALACHY’S REFURBISHMENT – WINDOWS

As Parishioners will be aware there is works required to St Malachy’s Church Ballymoyer, significantly the window frames need replaced or repaired and all glass needs repaired in the window. The Parish has taken on to do 2 windows which were at risk of collapse. To complete the work on the rest of the windows, as well as Paint the Church and other minor works, we are asking once again for your support.

We then invite Parishioners to make a donation to the overall cost of the windows. All donations toward these will be acknowledged on the website and in any future publication. The overall costs of the repair and restoration works of the windows is estimated to cost £65,000.00. We would welcome any donation towards the cost of these.
