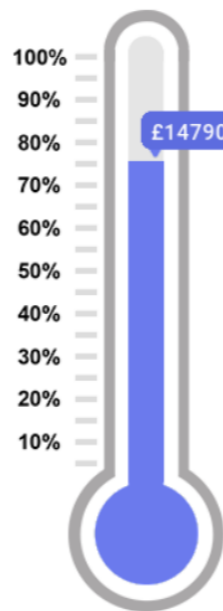


Adoration continues in the Parish each Tuesday evening in St Brigid’s Church from 7pm to 9pm.

We will have 2 courses which will be held in the Assisi Centre and are open to anyone who lives in the Parish.

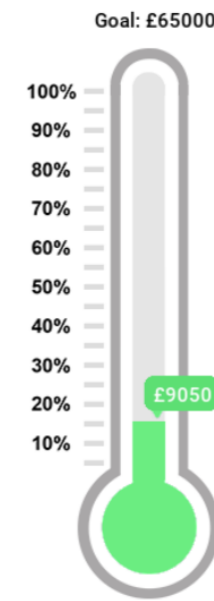
