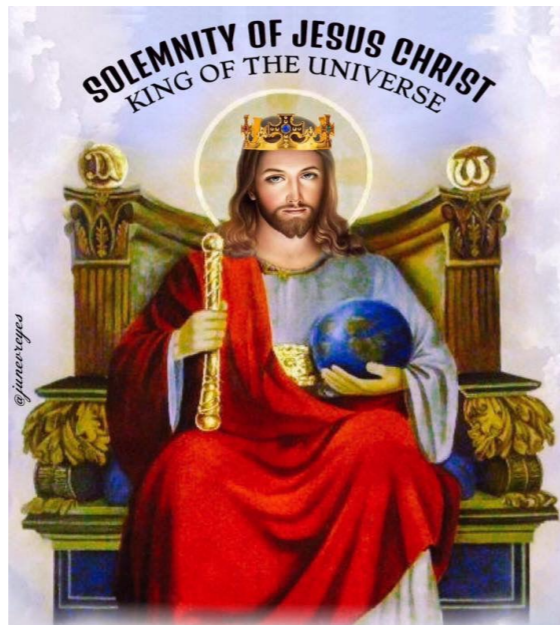
CHRISTMAS MASS BOUQUETS
