TROCAIRE DONATIONS



> We ask Parishioner to keep the inner Church doors closed to keep heat in our Churches and reduce heating costs.

We also ask that people please enter and leave through the side

door in both St Teresa's and St Brigid's Churches, the double doors should only be open in the event of a Funeral or due to an emergency. It cost the Parish over £7000.00 to heat the Churches last year, to date this year we have already spent £11000.00 so please help us reduce costs by not opening the double doors. Thank You.

UPDATE ON CHURCH REPAIRS

ST MALACHY'S - A further Window will be removed from St Malachy's Church after Easter as we received donations to cover this. We will then pause the restoration until further funds are available.

ST BRIGID'S – Some planned maintenance work was carried out in the Church recently and has now been completed.

ST LAURENCE O'TOOLE'S - As parishioners will be aware the parish begun to replace the roof on the Church which was essential – a damp specialist surveyed the building and informed us of woodworm, however we have now discovered water damage to various beams within the Church. We are awaiting reports from specialist and from structural engineers before we can make a decision on the next steps. What is clear however is that extensive funds will be required to repair the damage and ensure the church is left structurally safe.



We have a number of ways in which people can support the Parish to repair and maintain our four churches such as:

Contribute weekly to the Parish weekly collection and if you pay tax by signing up to the Gift Aid scheme. Therefore allowing the Parish to claim an extra 25p on every £1 you donate at no cost to yourself. As you are aware from the bulletin only about 113 envelopes are returned each weekend, we would therefore encourage anyone without an envelope to contact the parish – and then to use it weekly.
