ST PATRICK’S MISSIONARY APPEAL Next weekend we welcome Fr Brendan Payne, at all Masses, who will be making an Appeal on behalf of St Patrick’s Missionary Society (Kiltegan Fathers) The Society was founded on St Patrick’s Day 1932 by Fr Patrick Whitney. Since then, Kiltegan Fathers, together with Volunteer Priests and Lay People from different Irish Dioceses, including Armagh, have worked firstly in Nigeria and later in Kenya, Brazil, Grenada, Malawi, Zambia, South Sudan, Cameroon, Zimbabwe and South Africa. (www.spms.org) Today there are 210 Kiltegan Fathers of whom 55 are African with 90 seminarians preparing for the priesthood. That seed sown by the Irish Church has grown in surprising ways. Through our visit to the Parish, we wish to emphasize how missionary work is central to our faith as followers of Christ. There will be no collection at this time.
