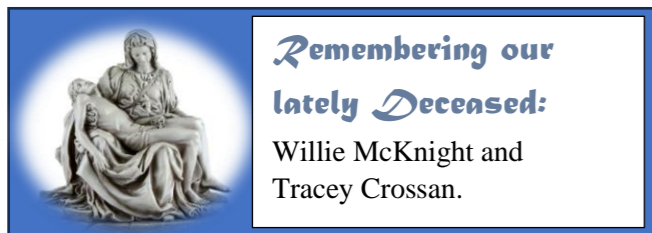

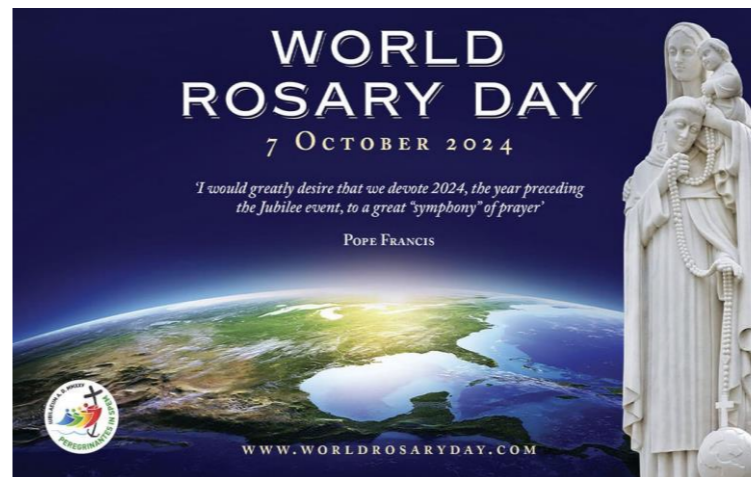
**SEASON OF CREATION – THANKS**
