Earlier this year we

were donated at £10 per slate/name.

This campaign did begin well, however, has been slow to raise any money of late. The total raised so far is £19,140.00 which is significantly short of our target amount of £50,000.00 for the roof. We also have a lot of other work to be done on the Church, so we do need to have more slates donated and also other fundraising activities taking place to cover additional restorations works such as plaster, heating etc.

lose.


