

Earlier this year we began a fundraising campaign to renovate St Laurence O'Toole's church called "Donate a Slate" with people able to remember a loved one either living or deceased on our online "Donate a Slate" website page. Slates

were donated at £10 per slate/name. This campaign did begin well, however, has been slow to raise any money of late. The total raised so far is £19,140.00 which is significantly short of our target amount of £50,000.00 for the roof. We also have a lot of other work to be done on the Church, so we do need to have more slates donated and also other fundraising activities taking place to cover additional restorations works such as plaster, heating etc.

We therefore invite people who wish to see St Laurence O'Toole's renovated and reopened to establish a fundraising group now as there is no time to lose.

Our "Darkness to Light" campaign in St Malachy's Church to restore our Church windows has so far raised £21,420.00 which has allowed us to restore 1 window completely and we will shortly begin to restore another two of the large windows to the front of the Church. There are still more funds needed to restore all the windows and so donations are still welcome, names of donors will be displayed on the Parish Website.
