While in previous years the Parish had a loan from the Archdiocese, we are happy to say that this loan has now been totally paid off, this however was paid back in the Financial Year ending March 2025 and therefore is not documented across.

CHANGES TO DIOCESAN LEVIES - Explanation leaflets available in the Churches

As previously mentioned, the levies paid by our Parish last year amounted to £8,525, with an additional £174.10 contributed towards the Student Priest Education Fund from the Special Collection. In total, our payments to the Diocese amounted to £8,699.10. These levies support various costs, including staff expenses at the Diocesan Office. To provide more transparency, the Archdiocese has printed an information leaflet outlining what these levies contribute towards. Copies are available at the back of the Churches. Due to current levy costs exceeding the actual expenses, a decision has been made to revise the levy structure, effective immediately: Central Diocesan Fund (CDF) Levy: 12% of our annual income from Weekly Collections, Gift Aid, and Shrines/Candelabra offerings. Based on this calculation, the Parish's new contribution will be approximately £12,090.96. Student Priest Education Fund Levy: 6% of the same income sources, amounting to about £6,045.48. The Priests' Benevolent Fund contribution will remain at £3,800 annually. Total Parish payments are therefore expected to increase from £8,699.10 to approximately £21,936.44. While many Parishes have expressed concerns about these changes, this is the current structure set by the Diocese. To help support the Parish financially, we encourage anyone who pays tax to sign up for Gift Aid, which can significantly benefit our Parish. Please note that Special Collections are not included in the levy calculations. To assist with parish projects such as Family Events and Youth Ministry, we have included Parish Development Envelopes in this year's donation boxes.
