June is the month of the Sacred Heart of Jesus I invite all parishes to join me in dedicating the month of June to the Sacred Heart of Jesus, invoking Christ's gift of peace - peace in our hearts, our homes, our country and our world. Earlier this week the Irish Bishops said: "We in Ireland must pray for a change of heart. Throughout the month of June the month of the Sacred Heart of Jesus - we call on everyone to pray for an outpouring of the compassion of God on a heartless world. To see the relentless bombardment of civilian areas, the deliberate withholding of food from the starving, as well as the callous holding of hostages, it appears that humanity has lost its heart. In the face of these horrors, we invite everyone to turn to the heart of Jesus throughout the month of June by praying for the renewal of heart that our world so desperately needs." This year marks the 350th anniversary of the Sacred Heart revelations to Saint Margaret Mary Alacoque at Paray-le-Monial in France. The relics of St Margaret Mary Alacoque and St Claude arrived in Sacred Heart Church, Cloghogue, on Friday 30th May and will remain there for one week. All are welcome. Every Blessing, Archbishop Eamon Martin. On the 22<sup>nd</sup> of June in Knock Archbishop Eamon will consecrate Ireland to the Sacred Heart of Jesus, here in our Parish I invite Parishioners to bring their image of the Sacred Heart (Pictures or Statues) to Mass on 21st/22nd June, Feast of Corpus Christi, where I will bless these images. I then encourage families to pray to the Sacred Heart for our Families and our World.
