We are thrilled that, thanks to the dedicated efforts of the Church Fundraising Group, we have secured funds to commence muchneeded work on the roof of St. Laurence O'Toole's Church.

We have placed some photos on our Facebook Page
which will help highlight some of the difficulties of the
roof issues. The Parish has been blessed by the Lord that,
thanks to Him the roof did not collapse in. In addition to
the roof repairs, we will be seeking external funding to
undertake a full restoration project for the church.
Donations however will still be needed if we are to totally
restore both St Laurence O'Toole's Church and
St Malachy's Church as well as maintaining the extensive
refurbishment which has been done in St Brigid's and
St Teresa's Churches. Both the Donate a Slate and the
Darkness into Light fundraisers are still ongoing.



Over the past few years, our Parish has been able to save significant funds thanks to the dedicated volunteer efforts in maintaining our three cemeteries. These savings have allowed us to carry out essential works on our churches and other Parish

facilities. A heartfelt thank you to the families who have generously volunteered to mow and maintain specific areas of the cemeteries. Your ongoing support is greatly appreciated. However, we are currently in need of additional volunteers for Tullyherron and Ballymoyer cemeteries, as some of our regular helpers are no longer available. If you are willing to assist by mowing or maintaining a designated section, please contact the Parish Office. Additionally, we require someone to empty the skip at Tullyherron Cemetery. The skip is currently full and needs to be emptied soon, especially in preparation for our upcoming Blessing of the Graves Masses. We extend our sincere thanks to all who have supported the Parish through these practical efforts. Your contributions greatly benefit our families and the wider community.
