
Just to let Parishioners be aware that scaffolding will be erected around the outside of the Church over the next fortnight, so the commencement of the new roof and supports can begin.

Our Mass Rock holds special significance; it was here that Cardinal Tomás Ó Fiaich celebrated Mass in 1983.

While we are no longer in penal times and have churches where we can worship freely, we remember and honour those who attended Mass at this Rock—and, sadly, those who lost their lives because of their faith.
