

This year marks the 400th anniversary of the birth of Saint Oliver Plunkett. As a man who sacrificed his life for the faith, he continues to inspire us to live with courage, integrity, and love today. Aware that many Christians around the world still face persecution for their faith, we encourage all parishes to gather in prayer for all Holy Martyrs—past, present, and future.

Our Mass Rock holds special significance; it was here that Cardinal Tomás Ó Fiaich celebrated Mass in 1983. During that service, he expressed his belief that Saint Oliver Plunkett would have celebrated Mass and other Sacraments at this very site. While we are no longer in penal times and have churches where we can worship freely, we remember and honour those who attended Mass at this Rock—and, sadly, those who lost their lives because of their faith.

We ask all First Communion and Confirmation Children to join us for this event - Please be aware that as it is in a field Sacramental clothing may not be appropriate.



Owing to the celebration of Mass at the Mass Rock this coming Friday, our normal Mass in St Brigid's will not be taking place. All our deceased loved ones will be remembered at our Mass Rock Celebration. Please note there will be NO

Eucharistic Adoration in St Brigid's before Mass on Friday. However, Adoration will take place as normal on Tuesday in St Brigid's from 7pm-9pm.

Fr Murphy will visit all those on his sick call list this coming Wednesday.

#### ST LAURENCE O'TOOLE'S RENOVATION

Just to let Parishioners be aware that scaffolding will be erected around the outside of the Church over the next fortnight, so the commencement of the new roof and supports can begin.

The delay was due to differing opinions of where the new beams should be placed - this has now been resolved. Please God, the repairs can continue to go forward in the coming weeks and months. I truly appreciate that you are anxious for the works to be completed, as am I, however it is important that when completed they are to a high standard and will be secure for generations to come. Thank you once again for all your prayers and support and especially the hard work of the fundraising committee.
